### Literacy

The children will be reading the books below



We will also be looking at some poems and rhymes.

The children will be learning to understand the concept of print and how English text is read from left to right and from top to bottom.

**Writing** This term, the children will be continuing to give meanings to mark making and draw using a variety of forms. The children will be supported to give meanings to the marks they make.

**RWI** -The children will be continuing learning the pictures of the sounds in set 1. We will continue to introduce Fred Talk so the children learn to hear and begin to try to blend together the sound to say the word .

### Maths

This term the children will be learning to use number names and number language to help them recognise numbers.

They will be beginning to learn to use the language of shape e.g. say circle instead of round and sphere instead of ball and use the language of size.

### Personal Social Emotional Development

This term the children will be learning and be inspired to talk about their feelings using words like happy sad, angry and worried.

To support the children's learning we be using 1 decision an interactive programme used by school.

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### Expressive arts and design

This term the children will be learning to draw with increasing detail e.g. to draw a circle for a face and include details like eyes, nose and mouth.

The children will be learning to remember the entire song and sing often in correct pitch.

### Educational visit

This term we are going to a play centre where the children can do various roleplay activities to help the children use their own personal experiences and imagination to help them extend their vocabulary.

### Physical development

This term we will be focusing on the children dressing themselves, putting on their own coats, doing up buttons and zips independently where appropriate.

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#### Important reminders

Please could you provide your child with spare clothes in case of toileting accidents and if your child gets too wet. The EYFS guidelines state children should be able to go outside in all weathers, so that means raining, cold and sunny. Please dress your child appropriate for that day weather.

### Communication and language

This term the children will be having longer stories read to them to help develop and focus their attention and encourage a love of listening to stories.

This will help support their exposure to a wider vocabulary and encourage communication skills.

### Understanding of the world

This term we will be learning about winter, Chinese New Year and Shrove Tuesday (pancake day). The children will be encouraged to talk about what they see and what they feel.

Winter -we will explore via touch and feel ice in solid form and see what happens to it.

Chinese New Year explore some food and cultural images and stories. 2024 year of the dragon.

Shrove Tuesday – history of what it is. The making of pancakes and decorating them.
